**B**anish dangerous toxic clutter from your home—bring it to the District's popular **Big Green Household**

**Hazardous Waste and Electronics Collection Event.** All residents are invited to bring their household hazardous waste, unwanted pharmaceuticals and old electronics to this free and convenient drive-through recycling event. District staff will even unload your vehicle for you! To save time and ensure safety, please place your hazardous waste in a cardboard box inside your trunk. Group similar products together and label anything not in its original container.

Now is the time to take care of those old cans of paint and stain, the gardening and automotive supplies you won't use, and that old cell phone that doesn't work. When you purge your house, workshop, office and garage of toxic materials you'll be doing your part to protect people, animals, the ocean and our planet.

If you're not sure about a certain product or electronic device please bring it—hazardous materials specialists will be on-site to answer your questions. All delivered items will be recycled, reused or disposed of properly. Check the list at left for examples of what you can bring to Big Green.

### Don't Flush Pharmaceuticals!

Bring your unwanted prescribed and over the counter drugs to the District's Big Green event (remove personal information from



prescription bottles). You can also dispose of pharmaceuticals throughout the year at the PBCSD Medical Waste Take-back kiosk located inside the fire station lobby (Mon.-Thurs., 10 am to 4 pm). Some local pharmacies also have take-back programs, or you can mix your unwanted pharmaceuticals with kitty litter or coffee grounds and place them in the garbage. **DO NOT** dump medications down the drain or toilet where they will end up in our waterways.
